


## Find and merge duplicate hardware sets

Wondering if you have duplicate hardware sets in your project? Now you can check!


Found under the Renumber Sets (A) button on the hardware set toolbar, Merge Sets (B) will search your project for duplicates sets.

Select what you want to compare (C).





**Pro Tip:** We highly recommend making a manual revision before you use this feature, just in case you would like to undo the results.



Set 2.0

To merge these sets, highlight the set you wish to keep and select Merge (G). If set 2.0 is highlighted, set 1.0 would be deleted from the project. All openings assigned to set 1.0 will change to set 2.0.


You can also Skip merging these two sets and continue searching the project/library for duplicate sets, or Stop the process.


#### Custom re-numbering of hardware sets


Another great hardware set update is the ability to customise your hardware set re-numbering.

You still have the ability to use the standard numbering sequence, but if you need to change it, click on Customise (A) on the re-numbering screen.

Similar to the 'Add a range of openings' feature, you can add a prefix or suffix to your sets (B). Please note that the Starting Number is the only required field. Sets will be renumbered according to your entries! (C)







**Future Feature:** We will be adding the option to customise re-numbering by groups of sets in the next release.

## New filtering on Add-Ons


Door and frame manufacturers frequently have a very long list of Add-Ons (1). Now, you have the ability to filter on this list.


Click on the appropriate cell in the Add-Ons column.

A new window will open with a dynamic filter at the top.

Type in your search term to automatically filter the list down (2).

Check the box or boxes to add selection/s to your Door Type or Frame Type.





## Revit 2023 plugin

It may still be 2022, but Autodesk has released their 2023 version of Revit! Also, to help you if you haven't had a recent update, 2019 is still available but no longer supported by Openings Studio.

To help your architects download the new plugin, direct them in the hamburger menu and then Plugins.

**Note**: Revit needs to be closed for installation.


**Helpful Hint**: Remind architects that they can launch Openings Studio from the Windows Start menu. A complete re-install in not necessary to add a new plugin and admin rights should not be needed.


Sometimes, analysing is a painfully long process for architects on large projects. In this release, we've added an option to do a Parameter Analyse (A) for Archicad projects over 300MB.


We recommend trying the Full Analyse (B) first, but if it's taking too long, use the Parameter Analyse instead!

**Note**: A parameter only analysis will not include a 2D or 3D view (C). However, you will still see yellow highlight changes in the Door & Frame Schedule and have the ability to map.




## PDF Editor - New page changer

An updated and much more user-friendly page changer (A) has been added for PDFs that have multiple pages.



## Right-click menu options

Flipping between tools in the PDF Editor is much easier! A \new right-click menu has been added to speed up your workflow. This menu changes slightly based on your last selected tool.



## Hardware set tag


Drop your hardware set number on PDF floor plans with the new Hardware Set Tag.


From the line button, click Add Hardware Set Tag (A).

Then click next to the door on the PDF to drop the assigned hardware set on the plan (B).

**Helpful Hint:** If the tag isn't placed where you want it, use the new right-click menu to switch to the Select Annotation option to easily move it.











Click on the Hamburger Menu (A) at the top of Openings Studio™.








Click on the Hamburger Menu at the top of Openings Studio (A).

An email will pop-up from your email client, pre-addressed to the appropriate support team. The e-mail will include helpful questions. Add your details and hit send (C).




